

3 EOP History

Cal State LA: 1968

- Instrumental in establishing EOP:
 - Black Student Union (BSA)
 - United Mexican-American Students Association (UMAS)
- Discovered 2% FTF = special admits could gain admission>Cal State LA
- Pushed administration > extend the special designation (mostly applied to athletes) to underrepresented students.



1968 SF State student strike

Spring 1968 50 special admit slots/underserved populations

Summer 1968 Associated Students \$40K 'Minority Student program'

Cal State did not grant the 50 slots Intense, public student demonstrations

Fall 1968 Pilot program admits the first 50 = Precursor to EOP



Senator John. L Harmer SB 1072, 1969

Other CSU campuses: 1968 <u>SF</u> State College: five months of protests/longest university student-led strike in history

1969: SB 1072 (Harmer Bill) established EOP as a CSU state-funded program

- ✓ EOP Provides academic support and retention services to students from first generation, historically low-income underrepresented backgrounds.
- ✓ EOP participants have the potential to succeed at a CSU yet have been unable to realize this potential because of their economic or educational history.

Eligibility

- ✓ California resident or AB 540 student.
- ✓ Low income > EFC \$1,500 or less
- ✓ First generation college (OK if brothers and sisters have earned a degree)
- ✓ Apply: Cal State Apply by the posted deadline and complete Financial Aid application
- ✓ SDSU provisionally admitted







- Language spoken at home
- Public assistance during the last 10 years
- Participated in Publically funded programs
- Work to contribute to family household






