


LOCAL ADMISSION AREA



GENERAL PATHWAY

Most majors fall into the General Pathway.



ELIGIBILITY

All applicants are admitted on a space available basis and must meet transfer admission minimum requirements.



GPA

Overall admitted student transfer GPA 3.30+

TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE (TAG)

TAG

All college course work attempted only at local admissions area colleges.



ELIGIBILITY

Meet the following five admissions eligibility requirements:

- 60 units
- General Education (GE)
- Major Preparation
- Grade Point Average
- Prior SDSU Coursework

EXCEPTIONS

Palomar and MiraCosta applicants are eligible for the SDSU TAG if applying to a program not offered at CSU San Marcos.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)



PRIORITY

Local ADT applicants receive priority admission over non-local applicants.



36 MAJORS PARTICIPATE

To qualify for admission through the ADT Pathway, applicants must apply to the appropriate Cal State Apply major. On the SDSU Supplemental Application, you must indicate you will complete the ADT degree by spring 2019 and confirm the name of the community college.




