Graduate Training Opportunities at SDSU Counseling & Psychological Services

C&PS provides a wide range of counseling and support services to the SDSU community. Our clinical training program is open to trainees and interns from various disciplines, including marriage and family therapy, clinical social work, and professional clinical counseling.

Our licensed therapists offer supportive and collaborative supervision with a focus on culturally responsive services, including:

- short-term individual, relational, and group therapy
- case management
- screening and referral
- crisis intervention
- outreach and teaching

Placements vary from 10-12 months for paid part-time positions (20-24 hours per week). We typically recruit for these positions starting in January and hold interviews in February.

Fifty to sixty percent of your hours are dedicated to direct service to students, while the rest is dedicated to supervision, training, consultation, and case management time.

Our therapists-in-training receive the following on a weekly basis:

- 2-3 hours of individual supervision, including mirror and video supervision
- 1-2 hours of multi-disciplinary group supervision
- 2 hours of didactic training on 2 hours of didactic training on topics related to diversity, psychotherapy, and professional development.

Our therapists-in-training start on August 1^{st} and are compensated for orientation during the first three weeks in August. We ask that you are present for up to 40 hours per week during orientation, prior to the first week of Fall classes.

- **2-3 letters of recommendation** (at least one letter from a supervisor with direct knowledge of your clinical work)
- **copy of transcripts** (unofficial copies will suffice)
