

Compact For Success

An agreement between SDSU and SUHSD which supports college readiness and a successful transition to university studies. Once admitted, students will join Compact Scholars and receive retention support from EOP, Outreach and Success during their time at SDSU.

Requirements: Class of 2025

Requirements to qualify for Compact for Success and receive guaranteed admission into San Diego State University (does not include admission to nursing or majors that have additional requirements such as dance, music, or theatre arts: performance):

- 1. Maintain continuous enrollment in Sweetwater Union High School District (SUHSD) from 9th-12th grade & graduate from a SUHSD school
- 2. Complete all A-G requirements with grades of C or higher by the end of senior year a. No D's or F's during senior year
- 3. Meet the minimum CSU GPA requirement at time of application and throughout the admissions process through graduation: **3.30** (class of 2025*)
- 4. Meet all SDSU admission/enrollment deadlines including submitting a first-year student application to San Diego State University via Cal State Apply by November 30

How To Demonstrate Compact Readiness

Demonstrate compact readiness in English (only one required)

- SAT score of 550 or higher
- ACT score of 22 or higher
- AP score of 3 or higher on either the Language Composition or Literature Composition exam
- A college level (100 level or higher) English Composition course completed with a grade of "C" or higher
- Early Assessment Program (EAP) via the CAASPP result of "standard exceeded"
- Early Assessment Program (EAP) CAASPP results of "standard met" and enrollment/successful completion of an approved EAP course in the 12th grade with a grade of "C" or better
- Grade of B or higher in one of the following courses during both semesters of senior year: AP English Language and Composition, AP English Literature and composition, English IB HL1, English IB HL2, CSU Expository Reading and Writing

Demonstrate compact readiness in math (only one required)

- SAT- score of 570 or higher
- ACT score of 23 or higher
- AP score of 3 or higher on either the AP Calculus (AB or BC) or AP Statistics exam
- International Baccalaureate score of 4 or higher
- A college level math course (100 level or higher, intermediate algebra level or higher) completed with a grade of "C" or higher
- Early Assessment Program (EAP) via the CAASPP result of "standard exceeded"
- Early Assessment Program (EAP) CAASPP results of "standard met" and enrollment and successful completion of an approved EAP course in the 12th grade and earn a grade of "C" or better.
- Grade of B grade or higher in one of the following courses during both semesters of senior year: AP Calculus (recommended for STEM Majors), Discrete Math, Pre-calculus, Calculus Concepts, Math Analysis, Mathematical Studies IB, AP Statistics, AP Computer Science, any course in Area "C" with designation as "Advanced Level Mathematics"
